Since I took office in the municipal administration, I have wanted to focus on the issue of accessibility, an aspect that I consider extremely important since the days when I was President of the Cortina Hoteliers' Association. The idea was to build a system that, also thanks to the 2026 Paralympic event, could transform the concept of accessibility into a new culture. Aware of the importance of a support network, I analysed the work done by some resorts on the

Adriatic coast, which are already active in this matter. In collaboration with the Veneto Region's Tourism Department, we therefore launched the project involving Village for All - V4A.

We set up a working table dedicated to accessible tourism, involved local facilitators, a Cortina Bank, and introduced training courses to encourage this cultural change. We know that accessibility is the result of a complex system that requires time, work, coordination and a lot of passion, but above all a long-term commitment. 

MUSEUM OF MODERN ART MARIO RIMOLDI

The Museum, inaugurated in 1974, has been declared of cultural interest by the Ministry of Cultural Heritage and Activities for being the result of a collecting process developed over fifty years, such as to constitute one of the most significant ensembles in Italy for 20th century art. It includes artists such as de Pisis, Campigli, Morandi, Sironi, Savinio, de Chirico, Guttuso, Music, Guidi, Vedova.

The museum, located in the city centre, has 3 floors connected by lift with dimensions 89 x 113 x 150 cm. The accessible toilet is on the ground floor and has grab bars. Possibility of downloadable audio guide with QR code.

PALAEONTOLOGICAL MUSEUM RINALDO ZARINI

Via Marangoi, 1 - 32043 Cortina d'Ampezzo (BL)

The museum presents a precious collection of fossils from the Triassic period found in the Cortina d'Ampezzo area, telling the 200-million-years old story of the geological evolution of this valley, enclosed in the traces of the earth. Shells of marine invertebrates, corals and sponges bear witness to a distant era when an immense expanse of seawater stretched over the Ampezzo valley.

Public car park with reserved spaces for disabled badge holders 350 metres from the entrance, with a mixed asphalt and sloping path. Floors connected by lift with dimensions 80 x 75 x 115 cm and possibility of downloadable audio guide with QR Code. On the ground floor there is a tactile work in 3D to discover the territory of the Cortina valley.



ETHNOGRAPHIC MUSEUM REGOLE D'AMPEZZO

Via Marangoi, 1 - 32043 Cortina d'Ampezzo (BL)

Located in a historic Venetian-style sawmill, it documents some important aspects of the culture of the Ampezzo community: the collective property of the Regole d'Ampezzo and how forests and pastures were managed. The valuable collections of artistic handicrafts, cabinetry, silver filigree, wrought iron and traditional clothes can also be admired.

Accessibility Info

The entrance has 6 steps equipped with a ramp with an 8% slope, with handrail on the left.

The 3 floors are connected by lift with dimensions 79 x 86 x 135 cm, possibility of downloadable audio guide with QR Code and to touch some of the exhibited tools.

CABLEWAY FALORIA

Via Ria de Zeto, 10 - 32043 Cortina d'Ampezzo (BL)

The cableway Faloria connects the centre of Cortina to the viewpoint of Mount Faloria, offering spectacular views of the Ampezzo valley and the majestic surrounding peaks. With a difference in altitude of 900 m, the cableway includes three stations: the lower station in Cortina (1,230 m), the middle station in Mandres (1,500 m) and the arrival station at Rifugio Faloria (2,120 m), where you can enjoy an unforgettable panorama.

The most panoramic point of Mount Faloria, at 2,123 m, offers a spectacular view of Cortina d'Ampezzo and the most famous World Heritage peaks. From up here, you can admire the splendid mountains that crown Cortina: the Cristallo Group, Croda Rossa, Pomagagnon, Tofane, Croda da Lago, Becco di Mezzodi, but also the peaks of Pelmo, Civetta, Marmolada, the Sennes Group, even the Tre Cime di Lavaredo are clearly visible.



Accessibility Info

The cableway has a pay car park with dedicated spaces for disabled badge holders. The entrance has a ramp with a slope exceeding 8%, so people with disabled badge and mobility accessibility needs can park near a side entrance that allows them to reach the cable car, which has a 12 cm difference in height to enter. Arriving in Mandres, it is necessary to change cable cars to reach the Rifugio Faloria. Here the panorama is breathtaking, and it is possible to relax inside the lodge and use the accessible toilet on the lower floor, which can be reached by lift or by an external sloping path.

FRECCIA NEL CIELO

Via Stadio, 12 - 32043 Cortina d'Ampezzo (BL)

From the centre of Cortina, the Freccia nel Cielo reaches the viewpoint of Cima Tofana at 3,244 m in 30 minutes, with two intermediate stops: Col Druscié (1,778 m) and Ra Valles (2,470 m). Both stops offer breathtaking views, allowing free stops before continuing. The lifts, which are fully accessible, also allow people with reduced mobility to admire the splendid scenery of the Dolomites.

Starting from the heart of Cortina, next to the Olympic Ice Stadium, the Freccia nel Cielo reaches the viewpoint of Cima Tofana at 3,244 metres in 30 minutes. During this journey to the 'sky', there are two intermediate stops, where you can stop and enjoy the mountain to the full, and then continue the ride at your leisure: Col Druscié at 1,778 metres and Ra Valles at 2,470 metres.

Accessibility Info

The cableway has a large pay car park with dedicated spaces for disabled badge holders. The main entrance has a ramp with a slope exceeding 8%, and from here it is possible to access the ticket office and entrance with turnstiles and a gate that can be opened by the staff dedicated to persons with mobility accessibility needs or families with prams. On the ground floor, there is an accessible toilet for people with disabilities and a changing table. The cable cars can accommodate up to 12 people, and the entrance is 74 cm. Once at Col Druscè, it is necessary to change cable car to reach Ra Valles, where there is a restaurant with an accessible toilet and a first viewpoint. The Ra Valles stop has a difference in height of 11 cm from the cable car and the restaurant/bar can only be reached by stairs. You can then continue on to Cima Tofane, reaching the cable car by means of a mobile aluminium ramp positioned as required. At the highest point, there is a panoramic terrace that can be reached with 2 steps or a ramp with a 19% slope, while the restaurant can only be reached by stairs.

During the Women's Alpine Ski World Cup, the Rumerlo area will become more accessible with polyurethane driveways suitable for wheelchairs, pushchairs and other devices.

Tactile maps will guide the blind and visually impaired to the parterre, grandstands and Tofana Lounge. The 'Prosecco DOC Sparkling Corner', toilets and spaces are barrier-free, with ramps and slides. LIS video interpretation is available thanks to Veasyt, as well as an audio guide in Italian and English with QR code realised with the International Speech Book Centre.

A magnetic induction panel for the hearing impaired will be available at the info point, amplifying sounds for hearing aids in 'T' mode.



THE ROUTES

Amidst centuries-old forests and imposing mountains, you will find scenic trails winding through the UNESCO World Heritage Dolomites. These routes allow you to immerse yourself in unspoilt nature, with breathtaking views of iconic peaks such as the Tofane and the Cinque Torri. Ideal for trekking, hiking and relaxing walks, many trails are also accessible to people with reduced mobility, thanks to modern infrastructure and cable cars. The experiences that we have selected for you in Cortina are two emblematic routes that will allow you to discover the magic of the Dolomites in all their splendid diversity: the E1 cycling/pedestrian path that crosses Cortina and the suggestive Pian de Ra Spines. Cortina is not just adventure: it is a journey into the authentic beauty of the Dolomites, suitable for everyone and available in every season.

PIAN DE RA SPINES



The Pian de Ra Spines is a 6.8 km loop around the Boite stream. Past the chalet Spiaggia Verde, continue to the information point, where the uphill path becomes asphalted and is flanked by a botanical trail and picnic areas with benches and tables. The enveloping silence connects you with the surrounding nature. Don't miss the waterfall of the El Felizon stream, and the Librascion, a book tree made by the students at the Artistic High School of Cortina.

- **Length:** 6.8 km (if you start from Cortina along the E1 it is approximately 13 km)
- **Types of terrain:** compact gravel, some gravel and asphalt sections
- **Caution:** in some short sections scattered roots on the path, the car access bars have a side gap with a minimum width of 90 cm and the entrance to the chalet path has scattered gravel piles and a 10 cm step Access only to the outdoor area and 2 steps to enter the Chalet

CYCLING PATH E1

SECTION OF CORTINA



The E1 cycling path runs through Cortina d'Ampezzo with a scenic route starting in Calalzo di Cadore and ending in Dobbiaco, crossing the heart of the Dolomites. About 60 km long, it follows the route of the old railway, offering moderate slopes and well-maintained surfaces. Along the route, cyclists and pedestrians can admire breathtaking landscapes, passing through the town. It is ideal for everyone, from families to cycling lovers, and allows you to immerse yourself in Alpine nature in total safety.

- **Length:** 60 km (the section in town is approximately 7 km)
- **Types of terrain:** asphalt
- **Caution:** there are frequent crossings of mainly low-traffic roads, in some sections the steepness of the route is challenging, in the section between the Faloria cable car and Ciasa Lorenzi the route runs on roads and pavements

It is located in the city centre and has 6 levels connected by two large lifts. Entry and exit are through an automatic glass door. All the shops have manoeuvring space for pushchairs and wheelchair, the narrowest aisles measure 110 cm and the maximum height of the tills is 92 cm. The supermarket is on the mezzanine floor and has products for coeliacs and other food allergies.

The lingerie shop on the second floor can be reached by a ramp with a 13% slope and handrail on the left; a larger changing room with a chair and lowered coat rack is also available here. Water dispensers are available on the first and third floor near the lifts. There is a home delivery service (for a fee) and trolleys where you can carry your small-size pets. Accessible toilet facilities under maintenance.

At the entrance 3 steps with handrails. Inside, textile books, hardbacks, pop-ups, and a tactile book. Upper floor accessible by stairs.


